

**THE AZAD JAMMU AND KASHMIR CODE OF CRIMINAL  
PROCEDURES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1969  
(Ordinance I of 1969)**

*(Passed under Government Order No. 1269-1300\SL\69,  
dated the 3rd June, 1969)*

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898), as in force in Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory ;

AND WHEREAS the State Council is not in session and the President is satisfied that immediate legislation is necessary;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Government Act, 1968, the President of the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir with the concurrence of the Chief Adviser, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Code of Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Ordinance, 1969.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 491, Act V of 1898:-** in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898 (Act V of 1898), as in force in the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory, in section 491, for sub-section (3) the following shall be substituted,

“(3) Nothing in this section applies to persons detained under the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Defence Rules, 1962. or under any other law relating to preventive detention as may, from time to time, be specified by the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

*Explanation:—*In this sub-section, the expression 'the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Defence Rules, 1962' means the rules made under the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Defence Act, 1951.".
