

**THE AZAD JAMMU AND KASHMIR ELECTORAL ROLLS  
(SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1970**

**(Ordinance IV of 1970)**

**AN ORDINANCE**

*Further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir  
Electoral Rolls Ordinance, 1970.*

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance 1 of 1970), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the State Council is not in session and the President is satisfied that immediate legislation is necessary ;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Government Act, 1968, the President, with the concurrence of the Chief Adviser, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 1, Ordinance I of 1970:-** In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance I of 1970), in section 1, for sub-section (3) the following shall be substituted, namely :

"(3) It extends to the territories under the administration of the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir and also applies to such of the State Subjects as were originally residing in those territories and the Indian occupied territories of the State of Jammu and Kashmir and are now residing in West Pakistan. "
