ACT

to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salaries, Allowance and Privileges) Act, 1986, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

1. **Short title and Commencement.** - (1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1990.
(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the first day of July, 1989.
2. **Amendment of Section 3, Act, VIII of 1986.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salaries, Allowance and Privileges) Act, 1986 (Act VIII of 1986), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in Section 3, for the word "three" the word "five" shall be substituted.
3. **Amendment of Section 7, Act VIII of 1986.**- In the said Act, in Section 7, in sub-section (1) for the words "twenty five thousand" the words "fifty thousand" shall be substituted.
4. **Amendment of Section 12, Act VIII of 1986.**- In the said Act, Section 12 shall be substituted as under and shall be deemed to have been so substituted on and from the 15th day of June, 1985.
"12. Medical Facilities: - (1) The Deputy Speaker residing in Azad Jammu and Kashmir shall be entitled for himself and his family free indoor as well as outdoor medical facilities of the standard admissible to a Class 1 Officer of the Government.
(2) The Deputy Speaker residing outside Azad Jammu and Kashmir shall be entitled to received for himself and his family:-

- (a) a sum of rupees five hundred per month in lieu of ordinary medical facilities;
- (b) in case of hospitalization in a Government Hospital, the actual expenditure incurred by him; or
- (c) in case the facility under clause (b) is not available, the actual expenditure incurred in a Private Hospital, duly verified by the Deputy Speaker;

Provided that a certificate of non availability of such facility by the concerned Government Hospital shall be necessary.”

5. **Addition of Section 15 and 16, Act VIII of 1986**:- In the said Act, after Section 14, the following new Sections 15 and 16 shall be added

“15. **Discretionary Grant.**— An amount of Rupees fifty thousand shall be placed at the disposal of the Deputy Speaker per annum for making discretionary grants in such manner as may be prescribed.

16. Telephone— The Deputy Speaker shall be entitled at Government expense to the use of one telephone at his office and two telephones at his residence both for official or private use throughout the term of his office and for a period of fifteen days immediately thereafter. He will also be entitled to free telephonic facility while on tour where such facility is available:

Provided that if the Deputy Speaker has not been provided telephones at his residence, he shall be paid Rs. Four thousand per month in lieu thereof.”
