further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986 (Act VIII of 1986) in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**-(1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 2014.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Section 7, Act VIII of 1986.**-In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986 (Act VIII of 1986), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in Section 7, in sub-section (3), in clause (ii) for the words "twenty thousand", occurring twice, the words "fifty five thousand" shall be substituted.
3. **Amendment of Section 10, Act VIII of 1986.**-In the said Act, in Section 10, in clause (a) after sub-clause (iii), following new sub-clause (iv) shall be added:-
“(iv) while on tour, if accommodation is not available in the rest house and the Deputy Speaker stays in a hotel, he shall be paid the actual room rent on production of proper receipt.”
4. **Substitution of Section 12, Act VIII of 1986.**-In the said Act, Section 12 shall be substituted as under:-
“12. **Medical Facilities.**- The Deputy Speaker shall be titled to medical facilities admissible in terms of the Medical Attendance Rules, except that he and his family shall be entitled to medical attendance at his residence.”
