ACT

to amend the Explosive Substance Act, 1908;

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Explosive Substance Act, 1908 (Act VI of 1908) as adapted in Azad Jammu and Kashmir, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Act may be called the Explosive Substance (Amendment) Act, 1992.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Insertion of Section 4-A, Act VI of 1908.**- In the Explosive Substance Act, 1908 (Act VI of 1908), after Section 4, the following new Section 4-A shall be inserted, namely:-
“4-A. (1) If any person receive injury due to an explosion as referred to in Section 3 or 4 of the said Act, the person responsible for such injuries shall also be liable for Qisas or Diyat as the case may be under the Islami (Tezeerati) Qanin Nafaz Act, 1974.
(2) The offences under this Section shall be triable by the District Criminal Court, established under the Islami (Tazeerati) Qanin Nafaz Act, 1974.”
