No. LD/250-57/2002. The following Act of the Assembly received the assent of the President on 11th day of April, 2002 is hereby published for general information:-

**AN
ACT**

to make law for establishment and functioning of Prime Minister Inspection and Implementation Commission and to regulate the functioning thereof and for the purposes ancillary and incidental thereto;

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

1. **Short title, extent and commencement:-** This Act may be called the Prime Minister Inspection and Implementation Commission Act, 2002.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Definitions:-** In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires following expression shall have the meaning as hereby respectively assigned to them:-
 - a) “Government” means the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - b) “Commission” means the Prime Minister Inspection and Implementation Commission established under Section 3;
 - c) “Inspection” means physical examination of a project, file etc; and
 - d) “Implementation” means carrying into effect of the orders of the Prime Minister or any other authority prescribed in this behalf.
3. **Establishment of the commission:-** (1) There shall be established a commission to be called as Prime Minister Inspection and Implementation Commission.
 - (2) The commission shall consist of Chairman, Senior Member and such other number of members and staff as may be prescribed by the Government.

(3) The Prime Minister Inspection and Implementation Commission established before the issuance of this Act shall be deemed to have been established under this Act.

¹“4. **Chairman.**- (1) The Chairman shall be appointed by the Government from amongst the senior Secretaries to the Government or any other person as the Government may deem fit.

(2) The Chairman shall be the incharge of the Commission and in his absence, Senior Member shall be the Acting Chairman.

(3) The Chairman shall have the powers to conduct the business of the Commission and for this purpose, he shall act, as Head of Administrative Department subject to the provisions of this Act.

(4) The Chairman shall be responsible to,-

- (a) assign various jobs/tasks to the members of the Commission;
- (b) endorse the inspection reports/comments on the complaints or any other report prepared by the members of the Commission;
- (c) look after the Budget and Expenditure of the Commission; and
- (d) submit all important reports to the Prime Minister for his

“4. Chairman:- (1) The Chairman shall be appointed by the Government on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Government on this behalf.

(2) The Chairman shall be in-charge of Commission and in his absence the senior Member shall be the acting Chairman.

(3) In discharge of his functions the Chairman shall be responsible to the Prime Minister and shall hold office during his pleasure.

(4) The Chairman shall be responsible to,-

- a) assign various jobs/tasks to the members of the Inspection and Implementation Commission;
- b) to endorse the inspection reports/comments on the complaints or any other report prepared by the members of the Inspection and Implementation Commission;
- c) look after the Prime Minister’s Inspection and Implementation Commission Budget and Expenditures;
- d) to submit all important reports to the Prime Minister for his orders.”

perusal and orders:

Provided that where a person other than senior Secretaries to the Government is appointed as Chairman, as provided under sub-section (1), the responsibility to look after the budget and expenditure of the Commission shall be on Senior Member.”]

5. Senior Member:-

(1) The Senior Member shall be appointed by the Government from amongst the Officers of Grade 20 & above of the Civil Service.

(2) The Senior Member shall have such experience and qualification as may be prescribed by the Government.

²“**6. Members of the Commission.-** The Government shall appoint members of the Commission from amongst the officers of the Government.”]

7. Staff.- The Government shall also be competent to appoint such number of staff as may be necessary keeping in view the budgetary allocation of the Commission in this behalf.

³“**8. Duties and Functions of the Commission.-** The Commission

“(3) The administration of the commission shall vest in Senior Member subject to overall control of the Chairman.

(4) The Senior Member shall allocate and divide the business of the Commission amongst the staff of the Commission.”

“6. Members of the Commission:-The Government shall appoint members of the Commission from amongst the grade 18 &19 officers of the civil service having such qualification and experience as may be prescribed by rules.”

“8. Duties and Functions of the Commission.- The Commission shall be responsible to undertake following functions,-

a) to inspect all developmental projects of Government Departments, Autonomous, Semi Autonomous and Local Bodies and put-up reports to the Prime Minister with its recommendations;

b) to take cognizance of any important matter of public interest;

c) to entertain the complaints concerning Inspection and Implementation Commission except those relating to service matters of the Government servants;

shall be responsible for the following functions,-

- (a) to inspect developmental projects of Government departments, autonomous, semi autonomous and local bodies and put up report to the Prime Minister with its recommendations;
- (b) to inspect or cause to be inspected all Government departments including police, autonomous/semi autonomous bodies, corporations, agencies, institutions and local bodies to see whether or not these departments/agencies/bodies etc. are discharging their duties/functions efficiently and expeditiously and to bring serious observations to the notice of the Prime Minister together with recommendations for improvement;
- (c) to take cognizance of any important matter affecting Government/public interest and draw attention of the authorities concerned for action;
- (d) to undertake special assignments which may be entrusted to it under orders of the Prime Minister, on any matter not specified in this Act;
- (e) other departments may assign specific important tasks to the Commission with prior permission of the Prime Minister;
- (f) to implement the directions and orders of the Prime Minister regarding development projects and other matters;

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- d) to review the progress of A.D.P (Annual Development Programme) twice a year and submit observations/recommendations to the Prime Minister directly;
 - e) to implement the directions and orders of the Prime Minister regarding development projects and other matters;
 - f) to make presentation of A.D.P review and follow up actions on the Commission's report to the Cabinet if the Prime Minister desires so;
 - g) to undertake special assignments which may be entrusted by the Prime Minister;
 - h) to monitor 'Follow up Action' on Commission's report and submit six monthly progress reports to the Prime Minister directly;
 - i) to issue Inspection Programmes and accompany the Prime Minister when required to do so."

and

- (g) to monitor 'follow up action' on Commission's reports and submit progress reports to the Prime Minister after every six month."']

¹[**8-A** **Powers of the Commission**.- The Commission shall have same powers of Inquiry in discharge of its functions regarding Inquiries, as the Commission of Inquiry has, under the Commission of Inquiries Act, 1956."']

9. Conduct of Business:- The Chairman may with the approval of the Government, make rules for regulating the conduct of the business of the Commission subject to the provisions of this Act.

10. Reports of the Commission.- (1) It shall be the duty of the Commission to present annually a report on the work done by the Commission, to the Prime Minister.

(2) The Prime Minister may issue direction to the Commission for the better performance of its functions.

11. Validation:- (1) All actions taken and work done by the Commission here-in-before shall be deemed to have been validly done, taken under this Act.

(2) All appointments made here-in-before in the Commission including the Chairman, Senior Member and members shall be deemed to have validly been made under this Act.
