No. 2283/SL/74. The following Ordinance made by the President on the 11th September, 1974, is hereby published for general information:-

(ORDINANCE XVII OF 1974)⁷

AN ORDINANCE further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Delimitation of Constituencies Ordinance, 1970.

WHEREAS, in pursuance of Section 50 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Delimitation of Constituencies Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance VII of 1970) in the manner hereinafter appearing.

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate legislation necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 41, of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. **Short Title and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Delimitation of Constituencies (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Section 4, Ordinance VII of 1970.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir D. limitation of Constituencies Ordinance, 1970 (Ordinance VII of 1970) in section 4, in sub-section (1), before the words 'Election Commissioner' the word 'Chief shall be inserted.
