## **ORDINANCE**

further to amend the Holders of Representative offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Holders of Representatives Offices (dis-qualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XCII of 1979) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- **Short title and commencement.-** (I) This Ordinance may be called the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Insertion of Section I4-A, Ordinance XCII of 1979.- In the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XCII of 1979), after Section 14, the following new Section 14-A, shall be inserted, namely:-
  - "14-A. Validation.- Notwithstanding any judgment, decree or order of any Court, including High Court, every thing done, all actions taken, notifications issued, orders or

appointment made, proceeding initiated, jurisdiction or powers exercised under the provisions of the Holders Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1978 (Ordinance IX of 1978) or its succeeding Ordinances issued from time to time shall be deemed to have been validly done, taken, issued, made, initiated or exercised under this Ordinance."
