ORDINANCE

Further to amend the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualifications) Ordinance, 1979

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XCII of 1979) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41, of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of Section 1, Ordinance XCII of 1979:**- In the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XCII of 1979) hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in Section 1, for subsection (2) and (3), the following shall be substituted and shall be deemed always to have been so substituted, namely:-

“(2) It extends to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir and shall also apply to all type of cases pending in any court or tribunal and all state subject wherever they may be.

(3) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the 13th day of March, 1978”.

3. **Amendment of Section 2, Ordinance XCII of 1979:-** In the said Ordinance, in Section 2, after clause (h) the following new clause (hh) shall be added and shall be deemed always to have been so added, namely:-

“(hh) “Public money” shall include money collected, whether by public subscription or otherwise and deposits in Cooperative Banks whether dissolved or existence.”
