AN

ORDINANCE

further to amend the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XXXVII of 1979), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of Section 41, of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- 1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979.
 - (2) it shall come into force at once.
- 2. **Amendment of section 2, Ordinance XXXVII of 1979.-** In the Holders of Representative Offices (Disqualification) Ordinance, 1979 (Ordinance XXXVII of 1979) in Section 2, in clause (g) for the proviso the following shall be substituted and shall be deemed always to have been so substituted.

"Provided that for the purpose of this Ordinance, any person in respect of whom a nomination paper was filed and he was a candidate for the elections to the Assembly, which were held in the year, 1970, 1975, or were to be held at any time during the year, 1977, or any person who has, at any time, been an Advisor to President, Advisor or special Assistant to Prime

Minister, during the period December, 1970 and August, 1977, shall be deemed to be a holder of representative office."
