**(ORDINANCE CCLXXIII of 1983)**

**AN  
ORDINANCE**

further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Servants Act, 1976..

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Servants Act, 1976 (Act VI of 1976) in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.** - (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Servants (Amendment) Ordinance 1983.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of Section 2, Act VI of 1976.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Servants Act, 1976 (Act VI of 1976) in sub-section (1) of Section 2, for clause (b) the following shall be substituted:-

“Civil Servant” means a person who is appointed to any Service of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir or holds a civil post in service of Azad Jammu and Kashmir employed in connection with the affairs of the State, but does include:-

(i) a person who is or deputation to the service of Azad Jammu and Kashmir in connection with the affairs of the Government, form the Council or the Federation or any Province of Pakistan or authority;

(ii) a person who is employed on contract, or on work-charged basis, or who is paid from contingencies; or

- (iii) a person who is a worker or 'workman' as defined in the Factories Act, 1934 (XXV of 1934) or the workmen's Compensation Act, 1923 (VIII of 1923).
