AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Maintenance of Public Order Ordinance, 1984

WHEREAS it expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Maintenance of Public Order Ordinance, 1984 (Ordinance LXIX of 1984), in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. Short Title and Commencement.- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Maintenance of Public Order (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 6, Ordinance LXIX of 1984.- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Maintenance of Public Order Ordinance, 1984 (Ordinance LXIX of 1984), in Section 6, for sub-section (4) the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“(4) Whoever craves or is likely to create or excite feelings of enmity, ill-will or hatred between different communities, sect, classes or sections of state subjects or which are of the nature referred to in Section 298-A, 298-B and 298-C of the Pakistan Penal Code 1860 (Act XLV of 1860) as inforce in Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

(5) In the even of disobedience of an order under sub-section (1) or contravention of sub-section (4) the Government or the authority issuing the order may, without prejudice to any other penalty to which the person guilty of the disobedience is liable, order the seizure of all copies of any publication

concerned and of any printing press or other instrument or apparatus used in the production of the publication.”
