**(ORDINANCE XLIX OF 1981)**

**AN**

**ORDINANCE**

to amend the Notaries Ordinance, 1980

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Notaries Ordinance, 1980 (Ordinance CXCIV of 1980) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

1. **Short title and Commencement.-** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Notaries (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981.  
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Section 2, Ordinance CXCIV of 1980.-** In the Notaries Ordinance, 1980 (Ordinance CXCIV of 1980), in Section 3, the full stop at the end shall be substituted by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:

“Provided that not more than two notaries shall be appointed in each District Head Quarter and one in each Tehsil Head Quarter.”
