AN

ORDINANCE

to extend the scope and functions of the Pakistan Engineering Council to the territories of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

WHEREAS it is expedient to extend the scope and functions of the Pakistan Engineering Council to the territories of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title, Extent and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Pakistan Engineering Council (Extension of scope and functions to Azad Jammu and Kashmir) Ordinance, 1981.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir territory.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Act V etc. to apply to Azad Jammu and Kashmir.**- The scope and functions of the Pakistan Engineering Council, hereinafter referred to as the said Council incorporated under the Pakistan Engineering Council, Act, 1976 (Act V of 1976), and the rules and Regulations made thereunder and the administrative orders issued under either of them shall extend *mutatis mutandis* to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir territory and the said Council shall function in the said Territory as it functions in Pakistan.

3. **Application of Articles and rules.** The Articles of the Pakistan Engineering Council as they are or as they may be amended from time to time and rules and Regulation made thereunder and the Administrative orders issued under either of them shall extend and apply to the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory as they apply or apply to Pakistan.
