**AN
ORDINANCE**

to amend the Superior Courts (Court Dress and Mode of Address) Ordinance 1983.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Superior Court (Court Dress and Mode of Address) Ordinance 1983 (Ordinance CLXXXVII of 1983) in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Superior Courts (Court Dress and Mode of Address) (Amendment) Ordinance 1983.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Section 3, Ordinance CLXXXVII of 1983.**- In the Superior Court (Court Dress and Mode of Address) Ordinance, 1983 (Ordinance CLXXXVII of 1983) for Section 3, the following shall be substituted, namely:-
3. A Judge of a Superior Court shall wear, while he is attending sittings of the Court, a black sherwani without bands white shirt, white shelwar or pyijama or a short coat of black material, White, shirt, with turn-down collar and black tie white trousers, in the Summer, and in the Winter, trousers of material in the deeper shades of a gray and a black gown.”
