No. 1092-96/LD/91. The following Ordinance made by the President on the 30th day of October, 1991 is hereby published for general information:-

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Cease Fire Line Incidents Relief Ordinance, 1991.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the Compensation of the property damaged by enemy action along the Cease Fire Line;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Cease Fire Line Incidents Relief (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect from the First day of June, 1991.
 - (3) It extends to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.
2. **Amendment of Section 2, Ordinance LII of 1991.**-In the, Azad Jammu and Kashmir Cease Fire Line Incidents Ordinance, 1991, (Ordinance LII of 1991), hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance:-
 - (i) in Section 2, in clause (f), between the words "damage to life" and the words "by enemy", the words "immoveable property" shall be inserted;
 - (ii) in clause (g) after sub-clause (ii), the following new sub-clause (iii) shall be inserted;

"(iii) Whose immoveable property is damaged due to enemy fire."

- (iii) after clause (g), the following new clause (h), shall be inserted:

"(h) Immoveable property means any property situated near Cease Fire Line."

3. **Amendment of Section 5, Ordinance. LII of 1991.-** In the said Ordinance, in Section 5, in the first proviso between the words "death or injury" and the words "shall not exceed" the words "or damage of immoveable property" shall be inserted.
4. **Substitution of Schedule, Ordinance LII of 1991.-** In the said Ordinance, the Schedule shall be substituted.
