AN

ORDINANCE

further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir President's Salary, Allowances and Privileges Act, 1975.

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir President's Salary, Allowances and Privileges Act, 1975 (Act XIX of 1975) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir President's Salary, Allowances and Privileges (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991.
(2) It shall come into force at once and shall take affect from 19th day of July, 1991.
2. **Insertion of Section 16-A, Act XIX of 1975.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir President's Salary, Allowances and Privileges Act, 1975 (Act XIX of 1975) after Section 16, the following Section 16-A shall be inserted;-

"16-A. In the case of resignation or - completion of the tenure, the President, and in case of death, his family shall be entitled to the following privileges for a period of fifteen days after the President ceases to hold office;

- i) Residential Accommodation.
- ii) Use of one official Car.

- iii) One Personal Assistant.
- iv) One attendant.
- v) Use of telephone at Residence.
- vi) Police Guard."
