AN

ORDINANCE

to regulate development and control of sports.

WHEREAS it is expedient to regulate the development and control of Sports in Azad Jammu and Kashmir;

AND WHEREAS the legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that the circumstance exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974 the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title, Extent and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Sports (Development and Control) Ordinance, 1987.
 - (2) It extent the whole Azad Jammu and Kashmir.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Definitions.**- In this Ordinance, unless there is any thing repugnant in the subject or context:-
 - (a) "Board" means a Board constituted under this Ordinance, for the control of Sports in Azad Jammu and Kashmir
 - (b) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules made under this Ordinance.
 - (c) "Prescribed" shall includes, Hockey, Football, Athletics, Wrestling, Cricket, Weightlifting, Squash, Swimming, Boxing, Cycling, Basketball, Golf, Volleyball, Rifle shooting, Table Tennis, Badminton, Lawn Tennis, Polo, Racing, Body Building, skiing, Mountaineering and any other activity which the Government may, by notification in the official Gazette, Specify.
3. **Establishment of the Boards.**- (1) As soon as may is, after the commencement of this Ordinance, the Government may, f or purposed of promoting and developing uniform standards of competitions in sports to in Azad Jammu and Kashmir, comparable to the standards prevailing internationally, and regulating and

controlling sports in Azad Jammu and Kashmir on a national basis, by notification in the official gazette, constitute, one or more boards for the control of Sports in Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

(2) A board shall be body corporate having perpetual succession and a common seal with power to acquire, hold and dispose of property, both moveable and immovable.

4. **Name, Constitution, Powers and Function of a Board.**- The name, constitution, powers and functions of a Board shall be such as may be prescribed by the Government.
5. **Exclusive right to make rules for the development, control and uniformity of sports throughout Azad Jammu and Kashmir.**- A Board may make rules and regulations for carrying out its objects into effect.
