AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Notaries Act, 1985.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Notaries Act, 1985 (Act XXVI of 1985), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Notaries (Amendment) Ordinance, 1991.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Section 3, Act XXVI of 1985.**- In the Notaries Act 1985, (Act XXVI of 1985), for Section 3, the existing provision shall be re-numbered as sub-section (1) and for the proviso the following shall be substituted, namely.-
"(2) There shall be twelve Notaries at Capital Headquarter, ten Notaries at Divisional Headquarter, six at District Headquarter and three in each Tehsil Headquarter."
