AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Stamp Act, 1899.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Stamp Act, 1899 (Act II of 1899) as adapted in Azad Jammu and Kashmir;

AND WHEREASE the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Stamp Act, (Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.
(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of Schedule I Act, II of 1899.**- In the Stamp Act, 1899 (Act II of 1899) as adapted in Azad Jammu and Kashmir, in Schedule I, in Clause (c) of item 40, for the words "two rupees" at both the places the words "ten rupees" shall be substituted. .
