**AN**

**ORDINANCE**

to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Deputy Speaker Salary, Allowances and Privileges Act, 1986 (Act VIII of 1986), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title, Extent and Commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1993.  
  
(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 1992.
2. **Amendment of Section 5, Act VIII of 1986.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Deputy Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1986 (Act VIII of 1986) hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in Section 5, for the word

"one thousand and two hundred rupees" the words "three thousand rupees" shall be substituted.

**Amendment of Section 10, Act VIII of 1986.**- In the said Act, in section 10, for the words "of one hundred and twenty five rupees" the words "at such rate as may be determine by the Finance Committee of the Assembly" shall be substituted.
