AN
ORDINANCE

to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) Act, 1975

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) Act, 1975 (Act XX of 1975) in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974 the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994.

(2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Substitution of Section 11, Act XX of 1975.**- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) Act, 1975 (Act XX of 1975) for Section 11, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“11. Leader of the Opposition.- The Leader of the Opposition shall be entitled to the same pay, allowances and privileges as admissible to a Minister under the provisions of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975 (Act XVIII of 1975) except Sections 11 and 21:

Provided that the Leader of the Opposition for the period

allowances as admissible to a Minister.”
