AN ORDINANCE

to amend the Notaries Act, 1985

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Notaries Act, 1985 (Act XXVI of 1985), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 41 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Interim Constitution Act, 1974, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- **Short title and commencement.-** (1) This Ordinance may be called the Notaries (Amendment) Ordinance, 1994.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- **Amendment of Section 3, Act XXVI of 1985.-** In the Notaries Act, 1985, (Act XXVI of 1985) ,in Section 3, for sub-section (2) the following shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(2) There shall be fifteen notaries at Capital Headquarter, twelve at Divisional, ten at District Headquarters and six in each Sub-Divisional Headquarter."
