No. 1349/SL/74. The following Ordinance made by the President on 20-4-1974 is hereby published for general information:-

(ORDINANCE No. II OF 1974)1

An Ordinance further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls Ordinance, 1974.

Whereas it is expedient to further amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls Ordinance, 1970 for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

And Whereas the Legislative Assembly is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate legislation necessary;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 24 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Government Act, 1970 and all powers enabling him in that behalf the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- 1. **Short title and commencement**. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1974.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Addition of proviso to Section 13-A, in Ordinance I of 1970.— In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Electoral Rolls

Ordinance, 1970, after sub-section (2) of Section 13-A, the following proviso shall be added, namely:

"Provided that fresh enumeration shall not be necessary and the existing electoral rolls may be published as draft rolls for the purposes of inviting claims, objections and applications for corrections."
